#### **Qualifications:**

- CAC III – active, good standing certification or licensure with the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies.
- Bachelor's degree.
- Must be able to work with a multi-disciplinary team focusing on mental health, trauma, employment and care management and be able to, or interested in learning how to work in a relational, assets-based, harm reduction model of services for women.
- Experience working with women who are homeless, drug addicted, living with mental illness.
- Must be able to provide services inside jails or prisons.
- Ability to work within multiple systems: criminal justice, community, treatment, etc.
- Self-motivated, professional, self-starter with a “can do” attitude and a strong work ethic
- Ability to manage multiple priorities and multi-task and complete follow-up activities
- Experience in data collection, analysis, and reporting. Good writing skills
- Commitment to practicing good conflict and anger management skills
- Prior experience/training in Motivational Interviewing, Trauma Theory, Stages of Change Theory preferred
